

PROVEN COPYRIGHT POLICY

Effective date: 3/06/2015

TicTasks, Inc. d/b/a Proven (“**Proven**”) has adopted the following general policy towards copyright infringement (this “**Policy**”) in accordance with the Digital Millennium Copyright Act of 1998, the text of which may be found on the U.S. Copyright Office website at <http://www.copyright.gov/legislation/dmca.pdf> (the “**Policy**”). The address of the Company’s Designated Copyright Agent (the “**Designated Copyright Agent**”) is listed at the end of this Policy.

It is Proven’s policy, in appropriate circumstances and at its discretion, to disable and/or terminate the account or access of users who repeatedly infringe or are repeatedly charged with infringing the copyrights or other intellectual property rights of others. Proven will respond expeditiously to claims of copyright infringement committed using the Site and Services that are reported to the Designated Copyright Agent.

Remember that your use of Proven’s Site and Services is at all times subject to Proven’s Privacy Policy and Proven’s Terms of Service applicable to your use, all of which are incorporated in this Policy. Any terms used but not defined in this Policy shall have the definitions given to them in Proven’s Privacy Policy.

A. Procedure for Reporting Copyright Infringements

If you are a copyright owner, or are authorized to act on behalf of one, or authorized to act under any exclusive right under copyright, please report alleged copyright infringements taking place on or through the Site or Services by completing the following DMCA Notice of Alleged Infringement (“**Notice**”) and delivering it to the Designated Copyright Agent.

1. Identify the copyrighted work that you claim has been infringed, or if multiple copyrighted works are covered by this Notice, you may provide a representative list of the copyrighted works that you claim have been infringed.
2. Identify the material that you claim is infringing (or to be the subject of infringing activity) and that is to be removed or access to which is to be disabled, and information reasonably sufficient to permit us to locate the material, including at a minimum, if applicable, the URL of the link shown on the Site where such material may be found.
3. Provide your mailing address, telephone number, and, if available, email address.
4. Include both of the following statements in the body of the Notice:
 - “I hereby state that I have a good faith belief that the disputed use of the copyrighted material is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law (e.g., as a fair use).”
 - “I hereby state that the information in this Notice is accurate and, under penalty of perjury, that I am the owner, or authorized to act on behalf of the owner, of the copyright or of an exclusive right under the copyright that is allegedly infringed.”

5. Provide your full legal name and your electronic or physical signature. Deliver this Notice, with all items completed, to the Designated Copyright Agent.

B. Once Proper Bona Fide Notice is Received by the Designated Copyright Agent

Upon receipt of a proper bona fide Notice, Proven reserves the right to:

1. remove or disable access to the infringing material;
2. notify the content provider, member or user who is accused of infringement that Proven has removed or disable access to the material; and
3. remove the infringing material of repeat offenders from the system and terminate such content provider's, member's or user's access to the Site.
